



BYLAW 98-7

OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF LESSER SLAVE RIVER NO. 124

Being a Bylaw of the Municipal District to enter into an agreement to establish an efficient and environmentally acceptable waste management system for the benefit of all participating municipalities with: Municipal District of Lesser Slave River No. 124, Town of Athabasca, and the County of Athabasca No. 12, in the Province of Alberta

WHEREAS, Section 7 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26.1 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1994, hereinafter referred to as the "M.G.A." provides for a municipality to enter into an agreement with other municipalities for a common purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the Municipal District of Lesser Slave River No. 124 has deemed it expedient and in its best interest to enter into such an agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipal District of Lesser Slave River No. 124, duly assembled hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the Municipal District of Lesser Slave River enter into an agreement with the municipalities of the Town of Athabasca and the County of Athabasca No. 12 for the purpose of construction, maintaining, controlling and managing a regional waste management system.
2. That a committee comprised of two (2) representatives of the Town of Athabasca, two (2) representatives of the County of Athabasca No. 12 and two (2) representatives of the M.D. of Lesser Slave River No. 124 be formed and that this committee be known as the "Athabasca Regional Waste Management & Recycling Authority".
3. That voting rights on the Athabasca Regional Waste Management Authority shall be:

Town of Athabasca	two (2) votes
County of Athabasca	two (2) votes
M.D. Lesser Slave River	two (2) votes
4. That the town of Athabasca act as sole banking agent and administrative centre with a Town representative to be chairman, and in the absence of a Town representative, a County representative shall assume the chair, and the Municipal Manager of the town of Athabasca to be Secretary-Treasurer.
5. That all funds for operation of the Committee be handled by the Town of Athabasca and that separate accounting records be kept for this purpose.
6. That the committee be authorized to disburse funds for the purpose of the Athabasca Regional Waste management Facility within the guidelines as established by the participating municipalities and to requisition on the formula as set out in schedule "A" attached.
7. That an audited financial statement be provided to each municipality by the town of Athabasca annually prior to March 31 for the previous calendar years' operations.

This Bylaw becomes effective upon the date of the final passing thereof.


