



BYLAW 2015-10

OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF LESSER SLAVE RIVER NO. 124

Being a Bylaw for the purpose of providing for the position of Assessor and appointing an Assessor as designated officer in accordance with the Municipal Government Act in the Municipal District of Lesser Slave River No. 124 in the Province of Alberta

WHEREAS, under the provisions of **Section 210(1) of the Municipal Government Act**, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, allow a Council to establish designated officer positions;

AND WHEREAS, under the provisions of **Section 284 of the Municipal Government Act**, the definition of Assessor means a person who has the qualifications set out in the regulations and is appointed by a municipality to the position of designated officer to carry out the duties and responsibilities of an Assessor;

AND WHEREAS, under the provision of the **Alberta Qualifications of Assessor Regulation (Regulation 54-99)**, requires that an Assessor must have certain minimum qualifications;

AND WHEREAS, under the provision of **Parts 9 through 12 of the Municipal Government Act**, indicates the duties and responsibilities of an Assessor;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council for the Municipal District of Lesser Slave River No. 124 in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

Definitions

1. In this Bylaw the following words shall be defined as:

- (a) "Act" means the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000 as amended.
- (b) "Assessor" shall mean a person who has the qualifications set out for assessors in the Municipal Government Act and who:
 - (i) Is designated by the Minister to carry out the duties and responsibilities of an Assessor under the Municipal Government Act; or
 - (ii) Is appointed by a municipality to the position of designated officer to carry out the duties and responsibilities of an Assessor under the Municipal Government Act;

And includes any persons to whom duties and responsibilities are delegated by the person referred to in clause (i) and (ii)

- (c) "Council" means the Council of the Municipal District of Lesser Slave River No. 124.
- (d) "Designated Officer" means a person as described in Section 210 of the Municipal Government Act.
- (e) "M.D." means the Municipal District of Lesser Slave River No. 124 or its duly authorized representatives.

Conditions

- 2. The position of Assessor is hereby established as a Designated Officer of the M.D.
- 3. The Assessor will be appointed and revoked by resolution of Council.
- 4. Pursuant to the Act, Section 210 (4), the Assessor is subject to the supervision of and accountable to the Chief Administrative Officer.
- 5. The appointment of the Assessor may be revoked by Council under the provisions of the Act, Section 211.

6. Powers, duties and functions of the Assessor will be as prescribed by the Act in Sections 284 to Section 304 inclusive, excepting thereout Section 202, Assessment for Linear Property.
7. That the Assessors and their respective staffs are deemed to be independent contractors and not employees of the M.D.
8. That any previous Assessor appointments are hereby rescinded.

Bylaw 2009-12 is hereby rescinded.


