

BYLAW 2009-07
OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF LESSER SLAVE RIVER NO. 124

in the Province of Alberta

to Appoint Bylaw Enforcement Officers

WHEREAS pursuant to section 7 of the Municipal Government Act, RSA 1994 the Council of the Municipal District of Lesser Slave River No. 124 may pass bylaws respecting the safety, health and welfare of people and the protection of people and property ;

AND WHEREAS it is desirable in the public interest, and in the interests of public safety, that council appoint Bylaw Enforcement Officers to enforce the bylaws of the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL FOR THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF LESSER SLAVE RIVER NO. 124, DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Definitions: In this By-Law :

"By-Law" means by-laws of the municipality;

"By-Law enforcement officer" means a person appointed as such by council;

"Chief By-Law enforcement officer" means a person appointed as such by council and includes a Bylaw Officer appointed by Alberta Justice as a Special Constable;

"Council" means council of the municipality;

"Municipality" means the Municipal District of Lesser Slave River;

2. The powers and duties of the Chief By-Law enforcement officer are as follows:

To ensure that by-laws of the municipality are enforced;

To provide for the supervision of the performance and conduct of the by-law enforcement officers of the municipality;

To respond to and investigate complaints;

To conduct routine patrols;

To issue notices, tickets or tags;

To report to council and carry out the directions of council;

To establish standards of uniform, insignia and identification for by-law enforcement officers;

To assist in the prosecution of breaches of municipal by-laws including the gathering of evidence, the attendance of witnesses and any appearances in court that may be required.

3. The powers and duties of a by-law enforcement officer are as follows:

To enforce the by-laws which council has authorized the by-law enforcement officer to enforce within the boundaries of the municipality;

To follow the directions of the chief by-law enforcement officer and to report to the chief by-law enforcement officer as required by him;

To respond to and investigate complaints;

To conduct routine patrols;

To issue notices, tickets or tags;

To assist in the prosecution of by-law contraventions including appearances in court to provide evidence;

To perform all other duties as may from time to time be assigned by the chief by-law enforcement officer:

To take the official oath prescribed by the Oaths of Office Act upon being appointed as a by-law enforcement officer and to carry upon his person at all such times as he is acting as a by-law enforcement officer evidence in writing of his appointment as a by-law enforcement officer of the municipality.

4. That the following person be appointed as Chief Bylaw Enforcement Officer:
