



BYLAW 2020-02

OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF LESSER SLAVE RIVER NO. 124

Being a Bylaw of the Municipal District of Lesser Slave River No. 124 in the Province of Alberta for the purpose of establishing an administrative structure in relation to the FREEDOM OF INFORMATION AND PROTECTION OF PRIVACY ACT, and to set fees thereunder.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 95 of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIP), RSA 2000, F-25, and amendments thereto, the Municipal District of Lesser Slave River No. 124 must designate a person or group of persons as the Head of the Municipal District for the purposes of the Act; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 93 of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIP), RSA 2000, F-25 and amendments thereto, the Municipal District of Lesser Slave River may set fees payable to the Municipal District for services provided under the FOIP Acts and Regulations.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipal District of Lesser Slave River No. 124, duly assembled, hereby enacts the following:

PART I – PURPOSE, DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION

PURPOSE

The purpose of the Bylaw is to establish the administrative structure of the Municipal District of Lesser Slave River in relation to the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, and to set fees thereunder.

DEFINITIONS

In this Bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires:

“Act” means the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, RSA 2000, F-25 and amendments thereto;

“Applicant” means a person who makes a request for access to a record under section 7(1) of the Act;

“Municipality” means the Municipal District of Lesser Slave River and includes any board, committee, commission, panel, agency or corporation that is created or owned by the Municipal District of Lesser Slave River and all the members or officers of which are appointed or chosen by the Municipal District of Lesser Slave River.

“Chief Administrative Officer” also known as “CAO” means the person appointed CAO of the Municipal District of Lesser Slave River, and includes any person who holds the position of CAO in an Acting capacity.

“Head” means the person or group of persons designated under Section 95 (a) of the Act.

“Province” means the Province of Alberta.

PART II – DESIGNATED HEAD

DESIGNATED HEAD

1. For the purpose of the Act, the CAO is designated as the Head of the Municipality.
2. For the purpose of the Act, the CAO may delegate any duties or responsibilities as deemed appropriate.

PART III – FEES

FEES

1. Where an Applicant is required to pay a fee for service, the fee payable is in accordance with the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Regulation, AR 186/2008, as amended from time to time or any successor Regulation that sets fees for requests for information from the Province.

PART IV – GENERAL


Bylaw 99-10 is hereby rescinded.


