



BYLAW 97-08

OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF LESSER SLAVE RIVER NO. 124

Being a Bylaw of the Municipal District to authorize the provision of Provincial Emergency 911 Services within the Municipal District of Lesser Slave River No. 124 in the Province of Alberta

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 7 of the Municipal Government Act, a Council may pass bylaws for municipal purposes respecting the safety, health and welfare of people and the protection of people and property; and

WHEREAS the Council for the Municipal District of Lesser Slave River No. 124 wishes to provide the Provincial Emergency 911 services within the Municipality and enter into agreements with other agencies and/or municipalities to provide such services;

NOW THEREFORE the Council for the Municipal District of Lesser Slave River No. 124 duly assembled acts as follows:

1. The Municipal District of Lesser Slave River No. 124 will enter into an agreement with Telus Communications Inc. to provide access to emergency services via its Provincial Emergency 911 Service.
2. The Municipal District of Lesser Slave River No. 124 will enter into an agreement with another municipality, society or business to provide Emergency 911 Call Answer Services and dispatch.
3. The Municipal District of Lesser Slave River No. 124 will enter into an agreement with Telus Communications Inc. in order that Telus will act as a billing and collection agent for the Emergency 911 Call Answer Service and dispatch.
4. A customer within the Municipal District of Lesser Slave River who subscribes to Telus Exchange Services will be provided with the Emergency 911 call answer service and dispatch and will be required to pay fees for the said service.
5. This Bylaw shall take effect on the day of it's final passage thereof.
