- Once approved, the project applicant is required to remove all fences, brush, rocks, and debris from the project site. Brush, rocks, and debris are not to be placed in the MDLSR road allowance.
- The landowner will be responsible for the burning/disposal of any brush piles created as a result of the backslope. Burning of brush will be subject to conditions of required fire permits.
- Upon completion, the area back sloped is to be kept free of weeds, brush, rocks and any other debris.
- The landowner is responsible for removing any fence prior to start of project and, if desired, is responsible for a new fence following completion of the project.
- The applicant shall submit a site sketch of the area to be back sloped.



Backslope Application

Please note the following Municipal District of Lesser Slave River (MDLSR) responsibilities:

- The MDLSR will provide grass seed following completion of the project.
- The MDLSR is responsible for the location of utilities (One Call).
- The MDLSR will not commence the work until the request is approved by MDLSR Council.
- The MDLSR will not commence any work until a written agreement is in place between the MDLSR and the Landowner.
- Council approved back sloping projects will generally be completed after harvest and before freeze up.

MDLSR Council will limit the number of projects only 1 (one) 800-meter (maximum) project per Landowner per year. All applications are subject to inspection by MDLSR staff before and after the commencement of any work for conformance with the MDLSR Back sloping Policy. If this backslope project is not approved in one calendar year, it will automatically be placed on the following year's project list for consideration by Council.
