## **POLICY STATEMENT:**

The Council for the Municipal District of Lesser Slave River No. 124 is entitled to recover tax arrears not related to land, via a distress warrant and seizure of goods. Seized goods will only be released upon full payment of the outstanding arrears plus costs.

---

## **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

1. As per the Municipal government Act, once goods have been seized under a distress warrant, any person may pay the tax arrears.
2. Only cash or certified cheque will be permitted as an acceptable form of payment before any release of seizure will be granted.
3. On full payment of tax arrears and costs, the municipality must release the goods from seizure.
4. A person may exercise the right under section 1 at any time before the municipality sells the goods at public auction or becomes the owner of the goods.
