The Municipal District of Lesser Slave River No. 124 corporation (i.e. Council and Administration) will do its part to foster economic growth to support its community identity, mission, vision and values by adhering to the following principles:

1. Maintain low rates of municipal taxation for the MD community: Namely, its citizens, businesses and industries, and farmers and ranchers;
2. Maintain low development levies and fees to developers;
3. Reduce administrative red tape; and
4. Use fees for service so customers can adapt their behaviors accordingly to what they consume.

The Municipal District will communicate and cooperate with its regional partners on a project-by-project basis where there is benefit or opportunities that logically accrue to the Municipal District community.

Otherwise, the Municipal District Council will set its economic development (which includes tourism) growth priorities, strategies and set aside appropriate resources to differentiate itself from competing regions.

The goal is to create new assessment for taxation to sustain right-sized municipal services and infrastructure that forms part of the basis for an enticing lifestyle in Lesser Slave River that complements economic opportunity and wealth.

Directions taken will be reviewed on a quarterly basis by MD Council against key performance indicators.
