POLICY STATEMENT:

The Municipal District of Lesser Slave River No. 124 owns and operates several recreational facilities and grounds throughout the municipality. In the event a public health emergency is issued under the *Public Health Act*, the Municipal District will follow the orders and guidelines as required by the province and ensure users of municipal facilities, are operating in compliance with any current and evolving conditions and restrictions that have/or will be issued.

DEFINITIONS:

Municipal District means the Municipal District of Lesser Slave River No. 124.

Public Health Emergency means a situation that poses a significant risk to human health and well-being.

PRINCIPLE:

To ensure the public and facility users are aware of any public health emergencies or advisories issued under the *Public Health Act* and that every possible and practical attempt to follow the order and guidelines will be made.

1. RESPONSIBILITIES

a. The municipality and the users of the recreational facilities have a shared responsibility as set by the orders and guidelines provided by the province and will adhere to and ensure the orders and guidelines are being followed.



2. MONITORING

a. Administration will monitor orders and guidelines regarding public health emergencies and update the facility's agreements to ensure users/renters adhere to any conditions/restrictions as set by the province and will inform Council of any pending changes that may need to be enacted.
