POLICY STATEMENT:

The Municipal District of Lesser Slave River No. 124 recognizes the importance of providing consistent snow removal and ice control at community facilities throughout the Municipal District.

DEFINITIONS:

“**Municipal District**” means the Municipal District of Lesser Slave River No. 124;

“**Snow and Ice Control**” means plowing snow or de-icing through the use of salt or other chemicals; and

“**Snow and Ice Removal**” means shoveling/plowing snow or de-icing sidewalks and door access areas.

PRINCIPLE:

The purpose of this policy is to provide Municipal District Service areas and Community Groups guidelines for reducing or eliminating snow and ice hazards and to minimize the inconvenience of winter conditions for users of community facilities.

1. Municipal District Levels of Services

- a. The Municipal District will clear the snow within seventy-two (72) hours when the accumulation of ten (10) cm (3.94 in) or more occurs at any of the Community Facilities.

2. Snow and Ice Control (Parking Areas)

- a. Snow and Ice Control will commence when the accumulation of ten (10) cm (3.94 in) or more occurs at any of the Community Facilities.

3. Snow and Ice Removal (Sidewalks/Building Entrances/Access Points)



- a. Snow and Ice Removal will commence with the accumulation of ten (10) cm (3.94 in) or more occurs at any of the Community Facilities.
- b. Snow and Ice Removal under ten (10) cm (3.94 in) at Community Facilities that fall under a Memorandum of Understanding will be the responsibility of the Community Group.

4. Snow Removal (Outdoor Ice Surfaces)

- a. Snow Removal on Outdoor Ice Surfaces will commence with the accumulation of ten (10) cm (3.94 in) or more occurs.
- b. Snow Removal under ten (10) cm (3.94 in) of snow on the Outdoor Ice Surfaces that fall under a Memorandum of Understanding will be the responsibility of the Community Group.
