**TITLE:** TOWING OF VEHICLES BY MUNICIPAL EQUIPMENT/VEHICLES

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** November 12, 1997

**POLICY NUMBER:** TR-32-13 (Supersedes E.14)

**STATEMENT:**

The Municipal District realizes that in extreme circumstances M.D. equipment or vehicles may be required to tow/pull out any private vehicle from being stuck on an M.D. roadway or road allowance where the safety of the driver, passengers or travelling public is deemed to be at risk due to extreme cold or other hazardous conditions.

**PROCEDURE:**

1. Should an M.D. employee be requested by a member of the public to assist in towing or pulling a vehicle that is stuck on a municipal road or road allowance, the employee should advise the M.D. office to send a tow truck on behalf of the stranded motorist
2. Should the situation be deemed hazardous to the safety of the driver, passengers or travelling public due to extreme cold or other hazardous conditions, the employee may at his/her discretion tow or pull out the other vehicle provided that the party requesting the tow/pull out completes the said Release, Waiver Indemnity Form (as attached)
3. The party requesting the towing/pulling out, must complete and sign the Release, Waiver, Indemnity Form **before** any municipal equipment or vehicle is authorized to commence a towing/pulling out situation
