Notice is hereby given that under the provisions of the *Municipal Government Act*, the Municipal District of Lesser Slave River No. 124 (MD) will offer for sale, by public auction, in the Council Chambers at the MD Administration Office located east of Slave Lake, Alberta, on Highway 2, on Thursday, **MARCH 27, 2025**, at 10:00am, the following lands:

Conditions: Each parcel will be offered for sale subject to a reserve bid and to the reservations and conditions contained in the existing Certificate of Title. No bid will be accepted, where the bidder attempts to attach conditions precedent to the sale of any parcel. The land is being offered for sale on an "as is, where is" basis and the MD makes no representation and gives no warranty whatsoever, as to the adequacy of services, soil conditions, land use districting, building and development conditions, absence or presence of environmental contamination, or the developability of the subject land for any intended use by the purchaser.

The MD may, after the public auction, become the owner of any parcel of land that is not sold at the public auction. Redemption may be affected by payment of all arrears of taxes and costs at any time prior to the sale. No terms and conditions will be considered, other than those specified by the MD. Failure to pay deposit on day of sale will result in disqualification.

Terms of Sale: The successful bidder must, at the time of sale, make a ten percent (10%) deposit in cash or certified

cheque payable to the municipality with the remaining balance due within 30 days of the Public Auction. GST and Land Title Registration Fees will apply on lands sold at the Public Auction. For further information, call 780.849.4888.

Dust Control Applications

To participate in the MD's Dust Control Program, applications must be submitted by **April 30**; late applications will not be accepted.

Rural living often comes with the challenge of dust from traffic on gravel roads, which can be both a nuisance and a safety hazard. The annual **Dust Control Program** provides a solution to help reduce this dust. The program runs from May to June, depending on weather and road conditions.

Each year, dust control agents are applied to specific MD roadways at no cost to homeowners. These include major intersections, hazardous school bus stops, hamlets, heavily developed residential areas, cemeteries, industrial parks, and residences located within 100 meters of roads with traffic exceeding 150 vehicles daily.

The program allows residents to apply for dust control on rural roads next to their private residences for a standard fee of \$350 per 100 meters, with an additional \$3.50 per extra meter. The program applies a calcium chloride agent to gravel roads, which binds dust particles together to prevent them from being carried by wind or traffic.
