### Utilities Account Required for Bulk Water Access

Effective **JULY 1**, all users of MD Bulk Water Stations **must** have an active **Utilities Account** to access any station. This

includes users who pay by credit card. To open an account, a \$100 deposit is required. A monthly service fee of \$22.40 will apply to all accounts.

**Usage rates are as follows:** Residential users will be charged \$3.88 per cubic metre for the first 45 m³; \$7.75 per cubic metre for any usage over 45 m³; and Commercial users will be charged a flat rate of \$12.50 per cubic metre.
